**Kilmainham Jail and Guinness Storehouse with Pub Lunch - April 19, 2010 Dublin \$75**

Enjoy a traditional pub lunch at the Brazenhead Pub, Ireland's oldest pub, established in 1198, where you will soak up the atmosphere of days gone by. After lunch, continue on to the nearby Guinness Storehouse, Ireland's top international visitor attraction. Learn about the brewing process that creates this beloved beverage and discover the technique needed to pour the perfect pint! Classic Guinness ads and memorabilia create a nostalgic ambiance as you indulge in a complimentary pint. Next, explore a sobering and moving aspect of the quest for Irish Independence when you visit the fabled Kilmainham Jail. Now a museum, this former prison once held individuals involved in the repeated Irish rebellions. The leaders of the famous Easter Rising were executed here. It was also from Kilmainham that Irish convicts were deported to the Australian penal colonies. Famous inmates included Charles Stewart Parnell and Éamon de Valera, who was elected president of the Republic of Ireland in 1959. The prison's population soared during the famine years as starving Irish committed petty crimes in order to be fed.
